

Plumas Charter School Code of Honor

As a member of Plumas Charter School community, I pledge to conduct myself honorably and in a way that shows pride in myself, my family, my school, and my community. As a person of honor I will show:

1. Respect for Academic Honesty in all my school work: I will not cheat, plagiarize, represent the work of others as my own, or allow others to copy my work.
2. Respect for Others in all my words, expressions and actions: I will be kind and polite to teachers, staff and fellow students. I will respect the privacy of others. I will behave in a way that helps me and my fellow students to do our best in school.
