Jennifer Van Acker, Lauren, Emilee, Beth McDonald, and Megan Neer on parent committee.

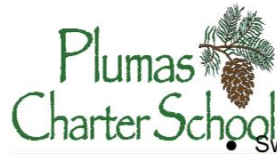
